### **Product Recall Information Notice**

The Regional Directorate of EFET in Epirus following Official Food Control at the company “ALLANTOPIIA IOV-THOMAS & FLORA MALAKASI S.A.” (in Greek: « ΑΛΛΑΝΤΟΠΟΙΙΑ ΙΩΒ – ΘΩΜΑΣ & ΦΛΩΡΑ ΜΑΛΑΚΑΣΗ Ο.Ε.») and in collaboration with the Veterinary Laboratory in Ioannina, found out the presence of the pathogen microorganism *Listeria monocytogenes* in a meat product (salami).

The implicated product is “Salami Lefkadas” (in Greek: « Σαλάμι Λευκάδος »), with production date 31/05/2014 and best before date 31/08/2014, which is produced by the company “ALLANTOPIIA IOV-THOMAS & FLORA MALAKASI S.A.” (in Greek: « ΑΛΛΑΝΤΟΠΟΙΙΑ ΙΩΒ – ΘΩΜΑΣ & ΦΛΩΡΑ ΜΑΛΑΚΑΣΗ Ο.Ε.») situated in the 34, Zabelion str. in Lefkada island (in Greek: « Ζαμπελίων 34 ») was characterized as non safe.

EFET requested the immediate recall-withdrawal of the total lot of the implicated product from the company. Relevant controls are in progress.

Consumers who have in their possession the aforementioned product (photo depicted below) are asked not to consume it.
